BY-LAWS

UNITED TRANSPORTATION UNION LOCAL NO. 426

SECTION I

This Local shall be known as United Transportation Union Local No. 426.

Regular meetings shall be held on the 4th Tuesday of each month at
7:00 ~~AM~~/P.M. in the Meeting Hall at Millwood Town Hall
E. 9103 Frederick, Spokane, WA 99206 subject to change as provided in Article 55.

The order of business shall be as set forth in Article 77.

SECTION II

Local dues of in-service members shall be \$ 6.00 per month, subject to change as provided in Article 48. The initiation fee for new members shall be \$.00
(25.00 Maximum)

SECTION III

The President of the Local shall be paid a monthly salary of \$ 60.00.

The Secretary and Treasurer of the Local shall be paid a monthly salary of \$ 600.00.

The Board of Trustees shall be allowed one (1) day's pay, at the daily rate applicable to the class of service in which regularly assigned, for the performance of duties as specified in Article 67, Constitution.

The provisions of this Article are subject to change as provided in Article 48.

SECTION IV

The Secretary shall arrange for flowers, or for a contribution to a designated charitable, research or fraternal organization, in honor of deceased members at a cost not to exceed \$ 75.00.

If the Secretary is not available another officer of the Local shall assume this duty.

SECTION V

All disbursements from the Local fund shall be made by check. Disbursements, except as provided in these by-laws, shall be approved by the Local before disbursement is made.

No expense will be allowed for attending Regional Meetings, seminars or other similar meetings unless attendance is approved by the Local prior to such meeting.

SECTION VI

Regular election for officers and committeemen shall be by secret mail referendum ballot, except the Alternate Delegate and Alternate Legislative Representative shall be elected by secret ballot at a regular meeting after the referendum election is completed.

Permanent vacancies, except as provided in Article 57, shall be filled by secret ballot of the eligible members present at a regular or special meeting.

All elections shall be conducted in accordance with the provisions of Article 57 and special instructions from the International.

SECTION VII

After giving reasonable notice to all eligible voters, these by-laws will be read at two regular meetings and, if approved by a majority of the members present at each meeting voting by secret ballot, shall become effective, and supersede any existing by-laws on the first day of the month following the approval of the International President.

Amendments to these by-laws shall be handled in the same manner. These by-laws were adopted March 15, 1994.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said Spokane Railway Credit Union, shall have by reason of this resolution, full right and authority to rely upon the same, and it shall be binding on this corporation until rescinded or modified by resolution of its Board of Directors, and a copy thereof served upon said Credit Union.
